ASC LANGUAGE SCHOOL

The ASC International is proud to have its own language school, the ASC Language School, where students can undertake academic English programs in order to prepare them for study in a mainstream secondary environment. Located in Perth CBD, students can study in our language school for up to four terms before moving on to any one of our school campuses for mainstream secondary study.

ENGLISH PROGRAMS

• Beginner English (General English) Course Code 078838J

This course is designed to introduce students to the early stages of English language acquisition in order to prepare them for the more academic style of English taught in PSS (see below).

• Preparation for Secondary Studies (PSS) Course Code 078837K

The Preparation for Secondary Studies (PSS) Course is an English language program specifically designed to prepare students for entry into secondary school programs. The course includes some subject content to ensure students become familiar with the vocabulary and terminology needed to study secondary school subjects successfully.

Students commence at the level best suited to their current language ability. All students are required to pass the Intermediate level of PSS before commencing their secondary course. Students in our PSS program may also partake in mainstream curriculum such as Science and Physical Education classes.

EAL/D (English As An Additional Language or Dialect) - for Year 11 and 12

We offer English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EaL/D) courses for Years 11 and 12 ATAR. The EaL/D course is designed for students who speak another language or dialect as their 'home' language. EaL/D focuses on developing the competent use of standard Australian English in various contexts and teaching academic English skills needed for tertiary studies. SCSA eligibility conditions apply.

- A copy of your passport
- Copies of your certified academic transcripts in the past two years (in English; please include original transcripts)
- Results of an English language proficiency assessment.
- Immunisation records (including Covid-19 vaccination record if applicable)

STEP 3: LETTER OF OFFER

Your application will be assessed and if successful, our office will issue you a Letter of Offer.

STEP 4: ACCEPTANCE

Return the signed Letter of Offer and arrange payment of fees as indicated. Register in the homestay database to complete your profile if you require homestay.

STEP 5: CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT

Once we receive all required documents, we will issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) and a Confirmation of Approved Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) letter.

STEP 6: VISA

Sumbit your visa application and advise us as soon as it has been granted.

STEP 7: PREPARATION AND ORIENTATION

Organise your travel details and advise us of your arrival date and time. Our Welfare Coordinator and the School will be in contact with some important redeparture orientation information. Make sure you review this carefully.

STEP 8: ARRIVAL INTO AUSTRALIA

Orientation will be held in ASCI office and we will inform you the date and time.
